KF-SCIS Simple Syllabus Guidelines

Beginning in the Fall of 2025, Florida International University will be requiring all faculty to use SimpleSyllabus as the format for their course syllabi.

SimpleSyllabus is a format that up to this point, has been used for University Core Curriculum (UCC) courses. Faculty can currently find SimpleSyllabus templates for their courses at the following link: http://fiu.simplesyllabus.com.

KF-SCIS Template

For KF-SCIS syllabi, a total of 27 components will be available by default. Those components are listed in the table on the last page of this document.

Not all of the components are required, however, and in many cases, faculty can control the content of these components, in addition to the audience that can view this content. These settings are controlled by two settings: Inclusion and Visibility. Note these settings vary, depending on if a course is UCC or Non-UCC.

Faculty also <u>always</u> have the ability to add new components to their individual SimpleSyllabus.

Inclusion

Inclusion refers to the ability of faculty to control: (1) the presence of the component, and (2) the content within the component. There are three modes here:

Mode	Meaning
Prepopulated	Component is required, and faculty cannot change the content (it is provided)
Required	Component is required, and the faculty can change the content
Optional	Component is not required, and faculty can change the content

If a component is "Optional", faculty can choose to remove that component from their SimpleSyllabus. Required and optional components may also have default content available initially (this is only for additional guidance), but faculty have the ability to change that content.

Visibility

Visibility refers to the ability of the faculty to control the range of individuals that can view the content of the component. There are three modes here as well:

Mode	Meaning
Public	Open access to everyone regardless of FIU affiliation, University-enforced, faculty
	cannot change to private
Public	Open access to everyone regardless of FIU affiliation, non-University-enforced,
	faculty can change to private
Private	Accessible only to faculty member and students in the course.

Importantly, <u>independent of the visibility mode, every component in a faculty member's SimpleSyllabus</u> <u>will always be visible to the faculty and their students.</u> Components that are private cannot be made public. University-enforced public material is far more common for UCC courses, which is enforced at the state level. This level of access on the Non-UCC side is restricted to prepopulated data that is public already and applies across all components (i.e. prerequisites, description, outcomes).

Common Operations

We provide guidance on what we anticipate to be the most common and basic operations for faculty when assembling their SimpleSyllabus – namely, editing a component, deleting a component, adding a component, and reordering components. For more sophisticated operations, we recommend you please reference the How-To Videos or attend relevant University event(s)/training sessions. Links to both are provided above under "Resources".

Editing or Deleting a Component

Standard text-editing capabilities are available for every component in a course:

Note this particular component is Optional, and can be removed from a faculty's syllabus by toggling "Visible" to "Invisible" (upper left corner). Additionally because the visibility is Private (and cannot be changed to Public), this setting is locked. If the component was non-University enforced Public, faculty would be able to toggle this setting to Private.

Adding a New Component

New components can be added by clicking "Add" on the upper left corner of the SimpleSyllabus:



You will then be taken to a screen that allows you to create a new component:

Once you provide a name for the component and click "Save", the component will be available for you to edit (both content and visibility).

Reordering Components

Clicking "Reorder" will provide the ability to reorder components of your syllabus:



You will then be taken to a list of your current components:
