Knight Foundation School of Computing and Information Sciences (KF-SCIS) Faculty and Staff Awards Procedures

Approved by KF-SCIS Awards Committee (October 2025)

The purpose of this document is to outline policies and procedures followed by KF-SCIS in determining faculty award recipients.

CEC Faculty and Staff Awards

The College of Engineering and Computing (CEC) offers four awards to faculty every academic year (AY): **Teaching**, **Research**, **Service** and **Mentoring**; in addition to three awards to staff: **Institutional**, **Strategic and Operational Excellence**, **Knowledge and Achievement**, and **Service Excellence**. When the office of the dean (CEC) issues the call for nominations, the awards committee or the KFSCIS director forwards the e-mail to the KFSCIS faculty and staff and encourages them, with emphasis on the previous year's KFSCIS award winners, to submit their nominations.

KF-SCIS Faculty and Staff Awards

KF-SCIS also defines several faculty and staff awards, also administered once per academic year (AY). Solicitation of these awards will commence in mid-fall semester, after the CEC student awards are complete. For all categories, the committee reserves the right to select no faculty if there are insufficient faculty rated "Outstanding", or more than the target number as well.

In the beginning of Fall semester, the Director will provide a list of tenure-track and teaching-track faculty members ranked as "Outstanding" in either one aspect or their overall annual evaluations, in addition to the evaluations themselves. The awards committee will evaluate these nominees and make their selection based on award criteria and eligibility, and provide the names to KF-SCIS Administration before the third Monday in November.

Tenure-track (TT) and non-tenure-track (NTT) faculty are eligible for various sets of awards, as outlined in the table below. Adjunct faculty are not eligible.
